

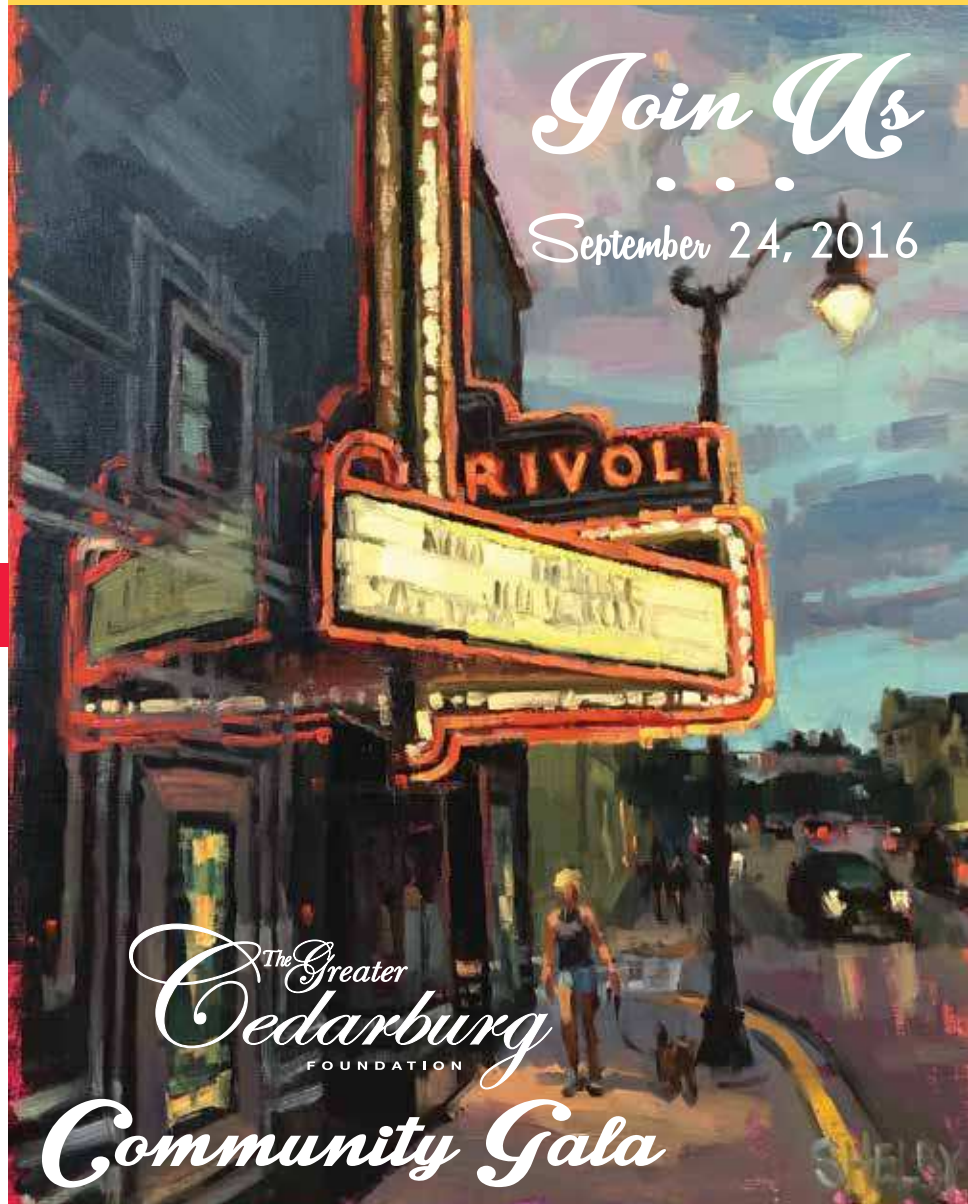


# The Greater Cedarburg FOUNDATION
